

Basic Law Act of 19 August 2011 of the Parliament

To: peace or stabilization mission

military, police, border guards, Government Protection From:

Agency, National Fire Brigade

Disabled veteran - official deployment

To: peace or stabilization mission

military, police, border guards, Government Protection Agency, From:

National Fire Brigade

Conditions of status: Disability and a loss of health or illness due to service in an operation - status of disabled veteran is granted by the Minister of National Defense.

Obligatory condition: compensatory benefits awarded

Medical services for disabled veterans – theoretically looks good	In practice – shortages of special clinics for badly injured, "Veteran's House" (Dom Weterana) is NOT well prepared for the disabled veterans (in reality looks like hospicium).
