Slovak troops deployed since 1993

- 30 military operations
- 21 countries
- 3 continents



- 16 UN missions
- 5 NATO operations
- 3 coalition operations
- 3 EU operations
- 3 OSCE operations

Since 1993 – 12 540 troops deployed (380 women)



2. Target group description

→ The law No. 463/2003 about the war veterans

- 90 days of military service abroad
- professional soldier in the Czechoslovakian army from March 14th 1939 till May 8th 1945 and was a member of the national fight for freedom
- 1939 – 1945 professional soldier in the Czechoslovakian
- 1939 – 1945 member of the national fight for liberation- military service in a coalition army
- 1939 – 1945 member of the national fight for liberation– member of the 1. Czechoslovakian army in Slovakia
- 1939 – 1945 member of the national fight for liberation– Czechoslovakian guerilla
- 1939 – 1945 member of the national fight for liberation– member of the Czech uprising of the Czech nation
- 1936 – 1939 Czechoslovakian volunteer in Spain
- Milan Rastislav Štefánik - War veteran in memoriam



2/1. Základné štatistické údaje

- 2. WW veterans – (400 – 500), the law no. 255/1946
- Recent veterans– over 17 000 rotations, over 12 500 personell, over 6 500 registrated
- The education – mostly university degree
- The veteran's age
- The number of veterans in service prevails over the retired
